McHenry, Illinois



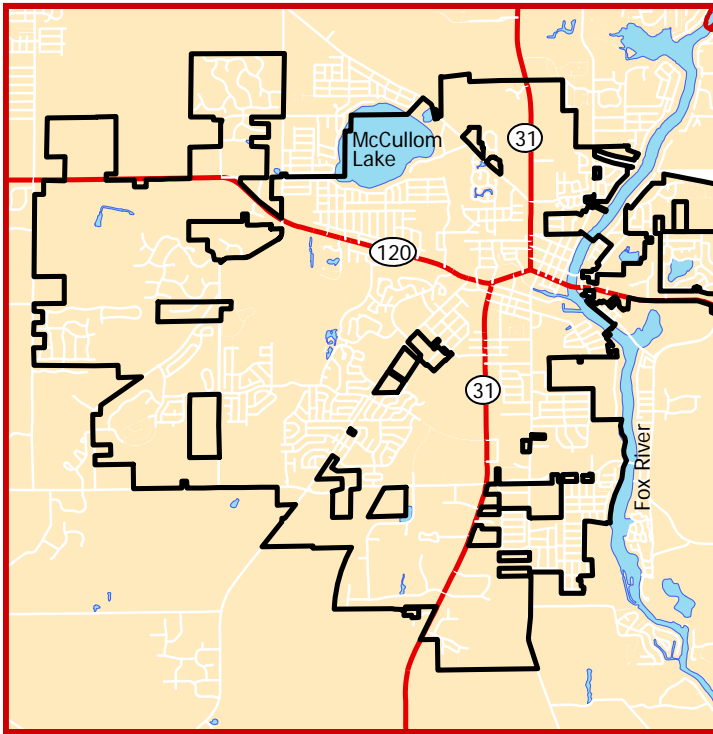
- Strategic location in Northern Illinois. Situated near four international & three regional airports.

Convenient and centrally located 50 miles northwest of Chicago, 45 miles east of Rockford and 10 miles south of Wisconsin, McHenry is situated along two major Illinois highways. Illinois Highway 120 links east and west McHenry, while Illinois Highway 31 ties north and south McHenry together. An estimated 35,000 vehicles traverse the City daily.

With Wisconsin and Lake Geneva minutes away, McHenry is central to commuting, tourism and large industry alike. McHenry is located in McHenry County which has a current population of over 300,000 residents.
